Nicolle Foland and Robert Orth appear as one victim's parents, Kitty and Owen Hart. Howard and Jade Boucher are portrayed by Gary Rideout and Catherine Cook. Theresa Hamm-Smith is Sister Rose. Joe Mantello director of McNally's Love! Valour! Compassion! creates the staging for Dead Man Walking, with costumes by Sam Fleming (in her Company debut), sets by Michael Yeargan and lighting by Jennifer Tipton.
